Kia ora e te whānau,

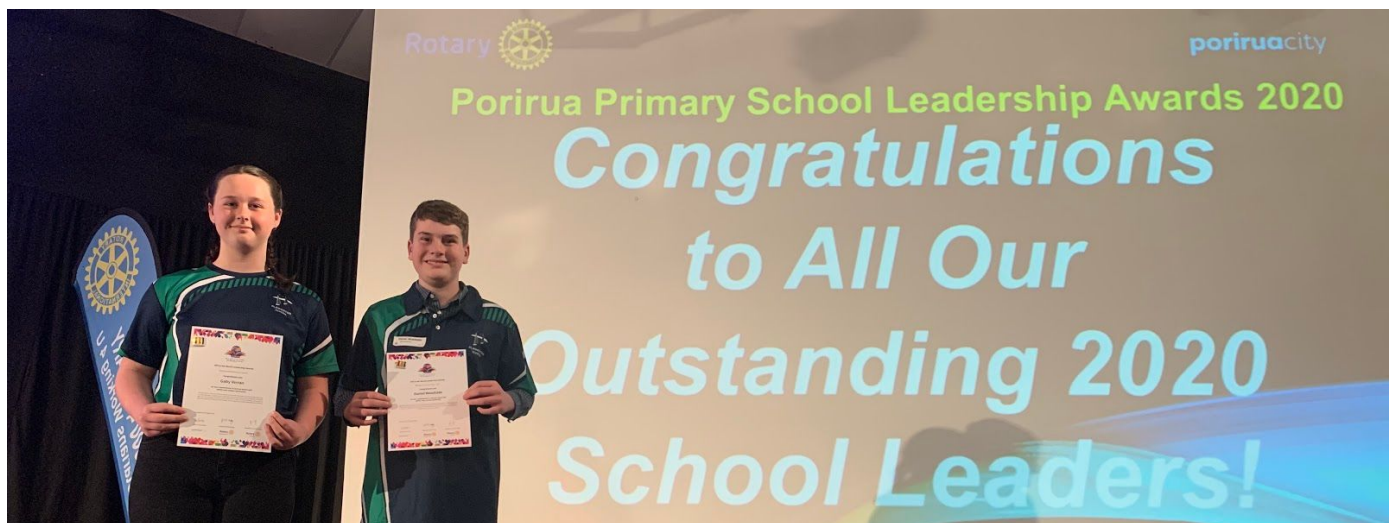
