Mai e te Tumuaki - From the Principal

Kia ora e te whānau,

Brrrrr! He makariri tenei ra! It is cold today! There are a few weather related items in today's panui. Wrap up warm for the weekend!

KEEPING WARM AND DRY AT SCHOOL

We are doing our best at school to maintain good ventilation (as a Covid prevention measure) and to keep classes warm. It's a tricky balance on cold days! Please make sure your children have some nice warm clothes each day.

It's the season for sudden downpours - which do seem to have a habit of arriving as students are walking to or from school! We are also trying to make sure children get plenty of outside time to have a break from mask-wearing and to get fresh air into them and the classrooms. A good raincoat (well-named) is a very good idea!



And if you have a child that has an affinity for finding puddles, having a change of clothes in their bag is an excellent idea!

CHANGING AFTER SCHOOL PICK-UP PLANS

Over the last couple of days we have been receiving a lot of phone calls in the office asking us to let children know about alternative arrangements for pick-ups after school. Please take the time in the morning before school to talk to your child/ren about a plan B in case the weather changes during the day.

If there is an urgent change of plans for other reasons - please ring the office before 2.30pm. This will give the office time to locate the child or teacher if they are out of the classroom. Teachers usually don't read their emails between 9am and 3pm, so emailing the teacher is not a great option!

KŌWHAI CHILDREN COLLECTION AT THE END OF THE DAY

From Monday onwards we will be going back to having Kowhai Syndicate children being picked up from their classrooms at 2.55pm. Teachers will no longer be bringing them down to meet you on the drive. We ask that you wear your mask on school grounds and please minimise mingling at school.

SAFETY IN THE CAR PARK AND AT THE GATE IN WINTER

When the wet weather sets in we get more cars doing drop off and pick ups. Add to this worse visibility, slippery road surfaces, and children (and parents!) more likely to be in a hurry to run unpredictably between the kerb and their cars and you can see how the risks of an accident ramp up.

Please drive a bit slower, show patience, talk to your children and model good pedestrian safety, and if you can park a bit further away and make use of your raincoats.
